



SCHOOL NEWS & INFORMATION

RE-REGISTRATION: Packets to re-register your child(ren) for the 2017-18 school year will be sent home tomorrow—Friday, January 20th. Signed registration forms and a registration fee of \$200 per child are due back on Friday, January 27th. A few important reminders:

- Forms and fee payment should be returned in the same brown envelope that they came home in.
- Re-Registration is due January 27th. Available space for new students will be assessed after that time.
- An application for extension will be included in the re-registration packet. **THIS IS A NEW PROCESS**. Students both currently enrolled in extension and students who may have a need for extension next year must fill out an application to be considered for a space. Students currently enrolled will be prioritized over students who do not currently utilize extension. **Extension applications are due January 27th!** Students not currently enrolled at SJS, but who are applying for the 2017-18 school year will have the option of applying for remaining spaces. Applications will be sent with the acceptance letter.

The tuition and fee scale that will accompany the re-registration packets was recently approved by the St. Jude School Advisory Council. All fee amounts will remain the same as the 2016-17 school year. Tuition will increase \$175.00 per child. While our primary goal is to keep Catholic education affordable for all families, the cost of benefits and healthcare is rising across the Diocese. This increases our largest expense– salaries. Please see the graphs below for more information in how expenses are funded by the various income at St. Jude School.





NEW STUDENT/SIBLING APPLICATIONS: Please note the application for new students (including siblings!) is posted on the website, and also available <u>here</u>. Applications are due to the school office by Friday, January 27th. Children wishing to begin Pre-K next year must be 4 years old on or before September 30th of 2017.

NEW STUDENT OPEN HOUSE: Do you know a family that would make a great addition to our school community?
