

## Sixth Grade Literature Summer Reading Assignment 2017

All sixth grade students are required to read **Freak the Mighty** by Rodman Philbrick. **Students should take notes while reading and bring the book to school on the first day of class.** A written test on this novel will be given within the first few weeks of school. This test is worth 100 points.

**In addition, students will select a second book** of their choice from the list below. An **Accelerated Reader** test will be taken on this novel during the first full week of school. This test is worth 50 points. In Literature class, students will need to have knowledge about the **main characters**, the **setting**, the major **problem or conflict** and how it was **resolved**, and the **theme or lesson learned** about this second book. **Students should take notes on these items because in addition to the AR test; they will take a written test worth 50 points on these items in class.** This too will be completed during the first full week of school.

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*Students should **ALSO** select one of the following novels to read:*

**QB1** by Mike Lupica

**Theodore Boone, Kid Lawyer** by John Grisham

**My Louisiana Sky** by Kimberly Willis Holt

**Surrounded by Sharks** by Michael Northrop

**The Dirt Diary** by Anna Staniszewski

**Capture the Flag** by Kate Messner

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In summary:

- **All** students must read **two** books.
- **All** students will take the following tests:
  - a **100** point test on Freak the Mighty
  - a **50** point AR test on the second novel of their choice
  - a **50** point written test on the second novel of their choice
