

Pre-Kindergarten Supply List 2018-2019

School supplies may be ordered online through the School Tool Box Company. Your child's supplies will be labeled and delivered to their homeroom teacher prior to the start of school. You will be emailed a link with ordering instructions when it becomes available later this spring.

If you choose not to pre-order supplies, the items on the below list should be purchased, labeled and brought to school the day of Pre-Kindergarten Orientation: **Thursday, August 2nd 2018 at 9:30 AM.** Please note that our proposed first day of school is Wednesday, August 8th. Students in Pre-Kindergarten will attend ONE day that week- August, 8th, 9th, or 10th – based on their last name. All students will begin as a full class Monday, August 13th. A postcard will be mailed at the end of July announcing your child's teacher and their staggered day entrance.

- 1 – Box of Kleenex
- 2 – Rolls of Paper Towels
- 1 – “Kinder Mat” (5/8” X 19” X 45” opened and folds 4 times) **Note: All oversized mats will be returned. No built-in pillows, blankets, etc. Space is limited.**
- 3 – Boxes of 8 **LARGE** Crayola Crayons (**not jumbo and not washable**) can be bought at School Aids

GIRLS ONLY: 1 – box *quart* Ziploc bags
1 – box *gallon* Ziploc bags

BOYS ONLY: 1- Clorox disinfecting wipes, pop up canister

Every child is to bring the following items on the day of Orientation, Thursday, August 2nd:

- 1 book bag, large enough to hold a legal size folder (no rolling book sacks)
- 1 LABELED, KING size cotton pillowcase (to fit over mat) **all oversized, too thick, fleece, flannel covers will be returned**
- 1 change of clothes in case of an accident, in a Ziploc bag. It does not have to be uniform clothes. Please include shorts/pants, shirt, underwear, and socks.

PLEASE label your child's mat, all sweatshirts, jackets, and any other clothing for easy identification.

Uniform recommendations:

- 1) Shoe: predominately white, navy, gray or black tennis shoes. Velcro is permitted in Pre K.
- 2) Elastic red or navy belt with magnetic buckle for young elementary boys
- 3) No rolling book sacks are allowed in Pre K – 4th grades
