



## **Application and Admission Information**

Applications for the 2021-22 school year are now available. They can be found on our website under the admissions tab. We will begin reviewing applications against our admission priorities upon receipt. All new students PK-8<sup>th</sup> grade must attend a screening for placement after their applications have been submitted. We will begin scheduling these screenings the first week of November.

We will start accepting students following the screening dates. Children who will be four years of age by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2021 are eligible to apply for PK. St. Jude has three sections of PK featuring 20 students per class.

The following procedure is used to prioritize applications for new students to St. Jude School:

1. Applicants (baptized Catholics) whose parents are registered and participating parishioners of St. Jude\*
  - a. Siblings of students presently enrolled
  - b. Siblings/children of alumni
  - c. Non-siblings/non-alumni
2. Applicants (baptized Catholics) whose parents are registered parishioners of St. Jude\*
  - a. Siblings of presently enrolled students
  - b. Siblings/children of alumni
  - c. Non-siblings/non-alumni
3. Applicants (baptized Catholics) whose parents are non-parishioners of St. Jude, but are validated participating parishioners of other Catholic churches
  - a. Siblings of presently enrolled students
  - b. Siblings/children of alumni
  - c. Non-siblings/non-alumni
4. Non-Catholic applicants
  - a. Siblings of presently enrolled students
  - b. Siblings/children of alumni
  - c. Non-siblings/non-alumni

\*A student who has not been baptized in the Roman Catholic Church or made a profession of faith through RCIC in a Roman Catholic Church will be considered non-Catholic for the purposes of admission and tuition. A participating parishioner is one who is an active participant in parish ministry (church and/or school) and is an Identified Stewardship Giver (ISG) through identified gifts totaling \$250 or more by December 20, 2020.
