Extension Registration 2023-2024

- Registration for the Extension Program for the 2023-2024 school year begins Tuesday **April 18th.**
- Applications for families currently enrolled in the program will be distributed by Mrs. Stacey beginning April 18th in the Extension office during Extension hours. Mrs. Stacey will not have forms prior to this date.

- Mrs. Peggy will not have forms at her desk.
- The non-refundable registration fee is **\$50/child.**
- The Registration Form, the Emergency Form and the \$50/child registration fee must be returned together by Tuesday April 26th in order for registration to be considered complete and a space secured.
- Since space is limited, spaces will be filled on a first come, first served basis. Once spaces are filled, we will begin a waiting list.
