- (1) Read the novel **Legend by Marie Lu**. Both an Accelerated Reader quiz and an in-class written test will be taken on this novel the first full week of school. For this novel, you will write your own title for each chapter. The title should reflect the plot of the given chapter. You will also write one question that YOU have about the novel at that point.

The chapters in this novel are not numbered. You should number your titles/questions chronologically and clarify whether the narrator of each chapter is either Day or June. There are 40 chapters; June is the narrator of the final chapter.

This **MUST BE TYPED and double-spaced**. **You will turn this in on the first day of class.** Please see the attached example for formatting.

- (2) Choose a second book from the list below. **Complete the attached notes page after you read the book.** You will take an AR test on this book. It will be a grade for the first nine weeks. A literature review will be completed on this novel by the third week of school. Information about a literature review will be given to students the first full week of school in August. **If a student took an A.R. test on the book during a previous school year, it will not count as summer reading for the 2024-2025 school year.**
