Carpool Reminders

Arrival Procedures:

- All students must exit the vehicle on the side closest to the school building. Students should not be exiting from the driver's side.
- Please have your child unbuckled and ready with all of their school materials prior to exiting the car.
- Please DO NOT stop and get out to help your child exit the vehicle once you have pulled through the school gates.

Dismissal Procedures:

- All students must load into their car on the side closest to the school building.
- Any car with a student riding in a car seat needs to pull through the gate, find one of the empty spaces in front of the activity center, and then buckle before leaving campus.
