- All Students may wear SJS sweatpants (purchased at Inka's). Girls may wear the sweatpants with a blouse or banded collar top. Wearing the jumper or skirt over the sweatpants is optional.
- All outerwear (sweatshirts, wind jackets, and fleeces) must be from either a uniform store or our H&S Association with the SJS logo.
- Jackets and coats are not allowed
- Girls in Pre-K-8th may have an option of wearing a solid navy cardigan.


