Message from Mrs. Gardiner

Dear St. Jude Families,

It is hard to believe we are nearing the end of the month of August - how time flies when you are having fun! For those families new to St. Jude, I want you to know your child is attending one of the top Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Baton Rouge. To our returning families, thank you for your dedication to making St. Jude the best! This year promises to be a year filled with wonderful opportunities for all our students as we strive to educate minds, evangelize hearts, encourage talent, and embrace the future.

We are happy to report our standardized test scores ranked St. Jude School in the top 15% of schools in the nation. GO COUGARS! Throughout the month of September, teachers will be analyzing the Terra Nova results and data to make informed instructional decisions for their students.

There are a few items to bring to your attention.

General Illness: Students who have flu like symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, and/or diarrhea, sore throat, or any other general illness may not return to school until they have been symptom and **fever free (without medicine) for at least 24 hours.** If a student checks out because he/she is not feeling well, he/she must have a note from the physician as to when the student may return.

COVID: There are cases of COVID in Baton Rouge. If a student tests positive for COVID he/ she will need to remain home for 5 days. He/she may return to school when he/she is symptom free after 5 days.
