Dear St. Jude Families,

On behalf of the faculty and staff, I would like to extend a big thank you to our amazing 7th parents for the "Treats and Sweets" set out each day in the teacher's lounge, as well as the cute Halloween decorations. We are so grateful for this gesture of kindness and appreciation. Below are a few items to bring to your attention.

40th **Year of St. Jude the Apostle School:** St. Jude celebrates 40 years of faith, academics, and excellence. Below is a brief history of St. Jude the Apostle School. St. Jude the Apostle School was established in 1983 as a satellite site to a neighboring Catholic school. We opened our doors with four classes in grades K-2 and a school secretary. In 1985, the school operated independently, hired a school principal, and continued to add grades and sections each year. Since the early years, St. Jude has expanded to a multi-faceted complex with 60 faculty and staff members, and 572 students. In 2020 St. Jude the Apostle School was awarded the National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence by the United States Department of Education. The National Blue Ribbon School award affirms the hard work of our students, teachers, families, and church community in creating a safe and welcoming school where students master challenging content.
