Grandparents' Day is finally here! Below are the logistics for Thursday and Friday:

#### THURSDAY—Parents' Performance at 1:00 p.m. in the Activity Center

- Performance begins at 1:00 p.m.
- Please queue up for afternoon carpool when you arrive to campus. You do not need to check in the office when you arrive. The performance will last about an hour and a half.
- Please stay for the entire performance!
- Once Grandparents' Day production is finished, immediately leave the activity center and head to your vehicle to begin afternoon carpool.

#### FRIDAY—Grandparents' Day Performance at 8:45 a.m.

- Grandparents/guests may begin arriving to campus at 8:00 a.m.

### **GRANDPARENTS DAY 2023 PARKING**

The ONLY entrance available for grandparents parking is the main driveway on Gardere, closest to Highland Road.

Grandparents will be greeted and **directed straight** along the lane closest to the **church steps**.



\*Turn **RIGHT** after the church steps.

\*Follow the lane around and enter the driveway into the FIELD LOT. Volunteers will assist with parking cars.

\*When the field lot is full, cars will be directed to the GYM PARKING LOT.

\*When the gym lot is full, cars will be directed to the MAIN PARKING LOT.



\*Turn LEFT after the church steps.

\*Follow the lane and watch for volunteers directing cars into HANDICAP SPOTS in the GYM LOT.

\*The FRONT ROW of the gym lot is reserved for handicap parking.

\*Volunteers will direct handicap parking to other reserved areas as needed.
