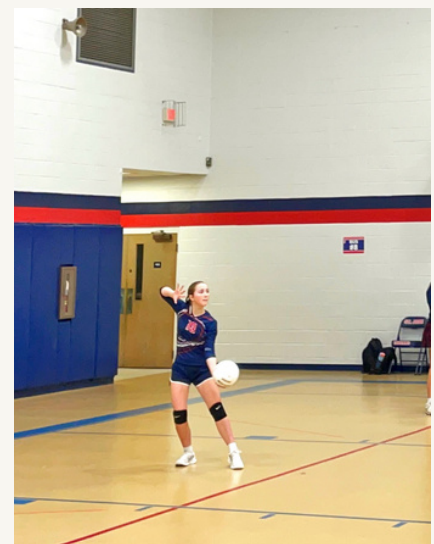

COUGAR RUMBLE
