Dear St. Jude families -

As we approach the week of April 14-18th, I would like to inform you about the upcoming Terra Nova Standardized Test that students in 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade will be taking. The Terra Nova test is an important assessment tool that helps us gauge your child's academic progress and identify areas where they may need additional support or enrichment.

The test schedule is as follows:

**April 15<sup>th</sup>:** Math (Part 1 and 2); **April 16<sup>th</sup>:** Reading (Part 1 and 2); **April 17<sup>th</sup>:** Language

**Testing on these days will begin promptly at 8:00 am**

Additionally, we wanted to inform you that standardized test scores for students in 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade will be included in the high school application process. These scores will serve as part of the comprehensive evaluation to ensure the best fit for your child's academic journey.

To ensure that your child is well-prepared for the Terra Nova test, here are some important test preparation ideas:

- **Encourage Adequate Rest:** It is crucial that your child gets plenty of rest leading up to and during the testing week. A good night's sleep can significantly improve cognitive function and concentration, which are essential for performing well on the test.
