- ▲ Car lines begin moving at 7:25 am.
- ⚠ Car lines will file in the parking lot from RIGHT to LEFT (the church side of the lot to the gym side of the lot).
- ⚠ When it is time for your line to move, follow the duty teacher or car in front of you through the black gates.
- ▲ Duty teachers will signal where to stop for your child to exit the vehicle.
- ▲ Children should be UNBUCKLED, READY to open the door and exit the vehicle with ALL OF THEIR BELONGINGS (backpack, lunch box, water bottle).
- ▲ Children exit the vehicle on the PASSENGER SIDE.
- ▲ Parents should NOT exit the vehicle. Duty teachers and student volunteers are stationed along the carpool drop off line to assist any child needing help.
- ▲ After exiting the vehicle, students PROCEED INSIDE to their classroom.


AFTERNOON CARPOOL REWINDERS

- Car lines begin moving at 2:50 pm. Afternoon carpool is TYPICALLY over between 3:12 3:15 pm.
- CARPOOL TAGS MUST BE VISIBLE for Mrs. Andermann.
- Car lines will file in the parking lot from RIGHT to LEFT.
- When forming lines, please PULL UP CLOSE to the car in front of you. Cars should be VERY CLOSE together both bumper to bumper and side by side.
- Mrs. Andermann will walk up and down each row CALLING STUDENT LAST NAMES over the intercom and assigning each car a cone #.
- When it is time for your line to move, PROCEED TO THE ASSIGNED CONE # to pick up your child.
- Students enter the car on the PASSENGER SIDE ONLY.

 If your child needs help buckling, DO NOT STOP and hold up the line. Pull up and proceed to the designated "Carpool Buckle Area" (see photo).
- If your child is NOT waiting at the assigned cone, the last name will be called again. Pull up and proceed to the designated "Carpool Waiting Area" (see photo).

CARPOOL BUCKLE AREA

Parking spots along the gym fence from side gym doors to the gym lot driveway. This area is found within the red box below. PARALLEL park in an available space to assist with buckling your child.



CARPOOL WAITING AREA

Parking spots along the gym from the black gate to to the side gym doors. This area is found within the red box below. Pull into an available spot and wait for your child to meet you.


