#### Band/Choir

Band: SJS Band Shirt with Jeans Choir: SJS Choir Shirts with Jeans

#### Pre-K:

1950s Attire: dress up attire from the 50th day of school, poodle skirts, jeans with white button down, etc. **FRONT ROW ONLY**: red shirt, red or denim pants, feather accessories, school to provide tail feather \*\*Parents of Front Row students will be contacted via email\*\*

#### Kindergarten:

1990s Country Attire: white t-shirt, dark bottoms (no leggings), denim overalls, flannel shirts, boots

#### 1st Grade:

Yellow/Rainy Day Attire: yellow shirt, jeans/denim skirt/yellow dress; **ALL** to wear yellow rain jacket or poncho (affordable options HERE and HERE)

#### 2nd Grade:

1970s Flower Power Attire: flower tops, bowling shirts, bellbottoms, etc.
